Since 1976 Applied Technologies, Inc. has provided the only <u>TRUE</u>, orthogonal Ultrasonic Anemometers based on the design of <u>Dr. Jagadish Chandran Kaimal</u> of NOAA.

The Applied Technologies, Inc. Ultrasonic Anemometer/Thermometer (called Sonic) incorporates state-of-the-art microprocessor and surface mount technologies. Software that computes the wind speed, wind direction and sonic temperature has been enhanced and optimized to provide a rapid response Sonic.

The calibration of the sensor is established by its design parameters; therefore, it can be used as an absolute wind instrument, with an accuracy that is controlled by the operator.

The electronics that operate our Sonic are located inside the probe array. Typically, the ATI Sonic is DC powered and is usually connected to a computer running a terminal emulation program or any type of data logger.

All of the ATI Sonics also have a variety of features and commands that are available to the operator. Using the terminal emulator program allows the operator to communicate with the Sonic and adjust or change these commands to modify the anemometer's performance.

The Applied Technologies, Inc. Sonic is a stable, low-powered anemometer, capable of running unattended for extended periods of time.

How Do I Set Up the ATI Ultrasonic Anemometer?

When you receive your Sonic from Applied Technologies, Inc., it will be packed in a sturdy cardboard box with foam packing material that has been cut to fit your probe style. We recommend that you keep the box and packing material in case you need to transport, store or return the product.

Inside the box you will find your Sonic Probe, Mounting Bar, Output Cable, Zero-Air Chamber and Manual. Carefully remove the contents of the box and verify that all the components are in good condition.

The manual has all the instructions required for setting up the instrument and plenty of information on what is going on and why. There is no ON/OFF switch, just attach power and it runs continuously.

If you feel that the Sonic requires calibration, use the Zero-Air Chamber provided to isolate the axes of the anemometer. A calibration can be performed at any time by you, the user. There is no need to return it to the factory for calibration. Calibration Instructions are provided in the Manual.
